## **Directions for Journal Writing**

After you complete each reading assignment, you will be required to write a journal entry. There will be a total of 10 journals.

The journal is a place to reflect, react, and connect to what you have just read. You may connect it to a personal experience, someone else's experience with whom you are close, something it reminds you of or why it angers you, concerns that arise because of this topic, a movie it reminds you of—the possibilities are endless. Think about it as a personal post on Instagram or Snapchat, but private. Be honest and as personal as you wish. No one will read your entries but me.

## **Requirements for journals:**

- 1. Must be in Times New Roman font, size 12
- 2. Heading must go in **upper right-hand corner** (no title is necessary):

Example: James Warner

June 18, 2019 Journal #1

- 3. Double space
- 4. At least one page long
- 5. Be mindful of writing conventions: spelling, grammar, sentence structure and punctuation.

**Note:** Journal entries are 10 points each. There is total of 10 entries required, which is a total of 100 points for the semester.

You will lose points for sloppy writing, multiple grammatical mistakes, and/or inadequate length.
