2) How to parenthetically cite a piece of information from the Shmoop summaries

Example 1: "His spear goes through the helmet and cleanly kills the man" (24. Shmoop Editorial Team). (*Direct quote*)

Example 2: In Book 24, Laertes successfully spears Eupeithes through his helmet, killing him swiftly and successfully (Shmoop Editorial Team). *(paraphrasing)*

Example 3: Laertes successfully spears Eupeithes through the helmet, killing him swiftly and successfully (Shmoop Editorial Team). *(paraphrasing)*

Parenthetical citation in essay:

If paraphrasing, simply cite the book number in parenthesis at the end of the sentence, if you do not mention it in the lead-in.
